On behalf of the WMS, I'd like to inform you of a unique and challenging opportunity in medical education that is available to your students.

In consultation with the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences (USUHS), the Wilderness Medical Society has developed a month-long elective that is open to all US and international students enrolled in an accredited allopathic or osteopathic medical school. The comprehensive, objectives and outcomes-based curriculum is designed to prepare future physicians for the complexities of providing medical care in remote and austere environments. It emphasizes basic clinical science with an exciting mix of practical, small group, case-based, and didactic training. Our next course will be held during the month of February 2011. Applications will be accepted beginning June 1st 2010.
